

HOW TO: Establish a Texas Mutual Online Policyholder Login Account


Texas Mutual allows policyholders the ability to access select electronic records and to provide access to authorized Users. Texas Mutual® online services provide the User with access to policy management information and allow the User to submit certain information to the Company including payments.

Pre-Requisites


✓ <u>Policy Information</u>: Texas Mutual policy number, company FEIN, and list of individuals to have access to online services. The policy must be active to process the online application.

Process Steps


Go to Texas Mutual's Log in



> Complete the Texas Mutual® Online Application

- Passwords are case sensitive. The system will prompt you to change the temporary password the first time you login.

Frequently Asked Questions

• When are the Texas Mutual® Online services available?

Registered users can access the *Texas Mutual*® online services between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m. daily.

Is there a limit to the number of authorized users that I can select?

There is no limit on the number of individuals who can be assigned a login account.

What is a FEIN?

The FEIN is your federal employer identification number.

- What are the types of privileges and access controls that I can assign to authorized users?
 - o Policy Inquiry user can view policy information
 - o Claim Detail Screen user can see claims filed along with payment details
 - o Policy Summary user can view coverage and endorsement information
 - Online Endorsements user can create and submit endorsements online
 - o Loss Runs and Analysis user can generate loss runs and loss analysis
 - o Claim Diaries user can view claim notes
 - o Dividends Inquiry user can view dividend amounts paid
 - Online Interim Audit user can file interim reports online
 - Safety Resources and File Injury Reports user can access the safety resource center and file injury reports
